### MISSION STATEMENT

The Mission At Kern County's purpose is to offer an environment conducive to the physical, emotional and spiritual well being of the people we serve by providing hope and a future through Jesus Christ.

### PROGRAMS

- **Homeless Intervention Services Center** – Services Include:  
Shelter, meals, showers, clothing, toiletries, counseling, employment opportunities, learning center, resume writing, rapid re-housing, case management and other emergency shelter services.  
**REQUIREMENTS of each guest**
  - 1) All guests will perform some work throughout their stay at the Mission
  - 2) Each guest must pick one of the following four tracks, of Intervention.
    - 1) Program – Ours or other recovery programs
    - 2) Jobs: must be in the search for work
    - 3) Vocational Training ( GED, and beyond)
    - 4) Government Assistance
- **Men's Residential Discipleship Program**- Christian 12 step one year program, that includes: Bible Study, Life-skills, Education, Counseling, Mentoring, Job prep, Celebrate Recovery, Relapse Prevention, Anger Management and more

- **Women's Residential Discipleship Program** – Christian 12 step one year program that includes: Bible study, Parenting, Life skills Education, Domestic Violence Mentoring Career Services, Job Readiness, Counseling, Anger Management, Celebrate Recovery and more.

- **After Care Residential Program**  
This is for Graduates of our one-year program. They can apply to live on grounds in a sober environment while they are getting back on their feet for up to 9 months. – Contact Program Directors (see above)

*Entry into any of the Mission's programs requires the following conditions to be met:*

- *To be able to pass a drug or alcohol test.*
- *Cannot be a PC 290 registrant (Registered Sex Offender)*
- *No violent offenders*
- *No Arson convictions*
- *To have a valid ID card*
- *Must be at least 18 years of age*
- *Cannot be on our no services list*
- *Must be physically able to leave the Mission without assistance in case of emergency*
